## Dreammakers at RMA

The women who become egg donors at RMA are known as “Dreammakers,” because they help to make the dream of a baby come true for other women. Through their dedication, other women can have the chance to experience pregnancy and childbirth.

To be an egg donor at RMA, you must be between the ages of 21 and 32 and meet certain health criteria. The process involves a series of tests, office visits and procedures all provided by the medical team at RMA.

## Compassion, dedication, commitment...

Hundreds of women have successfully completed the egg donation process at RMA. We provide all the necessary screening, tests and medications, and we also handle every aspect of the egg retrieval procedure. Our entire medical team is committed to making every donor’s experience as comfortable and convenient as possible.

To be an egg donor at RMA, you must complete a detailed application and undergo a series of medical and psychological tests. The process including follow-up monitoring can last up to three months. Donors can schedule many appointments at either of our locations in Connecticut. All egg donors at RMA remain anonymous and are compensated for their time and their commitment to completing the program.

## The egg donation process in detail

- Women interested in becoming egg donors at RMA must complete our donor application and provide a recent photo. For a copy of our application, call toll free at 800-865-5431 or visit [www.rmact.com](http://www.rmact.com) and click on the “Dreammakers” page.
- Eligible donors then meet with a specially trained coordinator at RMA to discuss the program in more detail and schedule the required medical and psychological tests. Most tests can be provided at either of RMA’s locations in Connecticut.
- Approved donors are then treated with commonly-used fertility medications.
- The eggs are retrieved in an out-patient surgical procedure at RMA’s Norwalk office.
- After the procedure donors typically have one follow-up visit with our medical team.
- Donors are compensated at the completion of the program with us.
